
Reduce, Reuse & Recycle



We strive to repurpose, refurbish, and repair these assets as needed, regardless of their location. When our clients wish to reconfigure or set up a new office, we access their inventory and redeploy it as required, minimizing waste and maximizing efficiency.

Supporting Our Community Through Furniture Donation



We helped Union Bank with a decommissioning project and were able to support over 50 charities. Ultimately, reducing their storage inventory by 70%, resulting in 38,769 total cubic ft of donated product with a value of \$1.5M. Some of the non-profit organizations who received donated furniture include:











State Fund turned during their transition to a hybrid work model. First, the focus was on re-homing items - reusing office furniture/equipment in other locations, while recycling or donating unneeded items to a third party. Second, on sustainably deconstructing pieces - dismantling items by their parts, such as metal and wood as recyclable resources.
